



**Position: Student Aviation Ambassadors – 16 years and older**

**Location:** 2088 Wellington Avenue, Winnipeg, Manitoba

**Time Commitment:** RAMWC is open 10:00 am to 5:00 pm 7 days per week. Volunteers self-schedule.

Mid-September to Mid-June: 3 hour volunteer shifts are available on weekends and holidays

During Summer Break, Spring Break and Winter Break: 3 and 6 hour volunteer shifts are available seven days per week

**Volunteering at Royal Aviation Museum of Western Canada (RAMWC)**

RAMWC is dedicated to preserving the history of aviation in Western and Northern Canada. We showcase 28 aircraft and many unique artefacts. We have a diverse group of volunteers who are enthusiastic in interacting with visitors. We provide a safe place for volunteers to discover aviation and aerospace while developing new skills. Volunteers can self-schedule and a minimum of 50 hours per year is required to receive a letter of recognition from RAMWC and to stay active.

Volunteers engage with visitors of all ages while in the museum's interactive zones and during public programming.

**Pedal Planes Attendant – Open to the public from Mid-June to Mid-September**

- Set up the Mini Tiger Moths on the aviation plaza at the beginning of the day and return to storage at the end
- Be observant and ask parents and children to be careful to prevent injuries and also not damage the planes
- Keep the area organized and litter free

**Science of Flight Zone – Open year-round to the public**

- Show visitors how the Musketeer Trainer, the Mini Helicopter and Wind Tunnel exhibits operate
- Give demonstrations of the mini-musketeer model
- Encourage children to participate
- Ask the visitors to stay outside of the barriers and to handle the instruments with care

**Pop Up and Family Activities – Days when public programming is offered**

- Participate in DIY activities, crafts, games and projects that keep families entertained.
- Offered during school's winter and spring breaks

**Special Event Days – Events are promoted on the museum's website**

- Be an ambassador during event days such as Halloween Carnival on October 26<sup>th</sup>, the Annual Easter Egg Hunt, Visiting Aircraft and Open Cock-pit days. During these large events, parking lot attendants are also needed.

**Requirements:**

- Students must 16 years or older
- Good verbal communication skills
- Willingness to develop leadership skills
- Interest in science, aviation, or aerospace
- Ability to do tasks independently
- Be reliable
  
- Volunteers aged 18 years and older must provide results of a criminal record check and vulnerable sector search.
